The Time and the Shape

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This presentation first introduces a logic that combines Linear Temporal Logic (LTL), and Separation Logic (SL). Then, it presents how this combined logic can be used on the generation of Runtime Verification monitors that are used to verify whether structural, and temporal properties hold for a given system.
